Return-to-work Briefings

Face masks are non-surgical type to avoid taking supply lines from NHS.

Washable/reusable to reduce waste.

COVID-19 Specific Method Statements and Risk Assessments

Documents issued per site to highlight the risks and problem areas throughout, along with their control measures and systems to be used to combat them.

Ongoing briefings as any changes occur on site.

Sanitiser Stands

Free-standing sanitiser dispensers can be placed around site to give site staff more opportunities to use hand sanitiser.

Near Honeywagons, busy entry/exit points etc.

Cleaning Protocol

Any equipment coming/going from our yard will have additional cleaning protocols in place – now to use cleaning materials certified to BS 14476, as used by the NHS.
